

THE PURPOSE OF PENTACOST

Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see; for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have. Luk 24:39

It is I myself, I am not a spirit,

Here is my first very important point that I want to bring home to you this morning beloved and that we must understand if we want to have the full effect and the full blessing and the full purpose of pentacost, and that is that Jesus died and rose again from the grave, not for himself,

but to raise up the body of Christ, to raise up his people ...
and his kin and to make them in a true sense,
his bone and his flesh filled with his spirit.

My brothers and sisters, this is a vital part of pentecost –
that God has come to dwell in us.

By His Spirit, halleluja and as I am full of the spirit of life,
I am victorious over the spirit of death.

I am not speaking of immortality beloved, I know that before Jesus comes and should He tarry,
we have a lifespan that is still part of the penalty,
that is still part of the judgement of the first sin,
but while I am in this body
Jesus has come to fill me with his spirit.
And therefore, that spirit is the spirit of life
and I am of his flesh and of his bone.
